LTBL is not arriving in St. Elizabeth Parish as an outside institution. We are planting ourselves here, permanently, in a parish still rebuilding from Hurricane Melissa, because restoration is exactly what this moment calls for.

I OUR APPROACH

- **Relationship before request.** Every partnership, government, church, school, begins with listening, not asking.
- **Local first.** Wherever possible, we hire locally, source locally, and build local capacity rather than importing solutions from outside.
- **No competition, only collaboration.** We are not here to compete with existing schools or churches for students or congregants. We exist to serve alongside them.
- **Transparency with government partners.** We engage MOEY, CPFSA, and parish authorities honestly, at every stage, even when the process is slow.

2 HOW THE COMMUNITY CAN ENGAGE WITH US

- **Churches:** partnership conversations for shared ministry, not recruitment
- **Schools:** the Time-Out Initiative operates independently, never in competition with a school's own enrollment
- **Local businesses:** sourcing, vendor relationships, and CSR partnerships as we grow
- **Families:** direct engagement through our programs, always free where children are concerned unless stated otherwise
